#### **Disability Living Allowance**



Disability Living Allowance (DLA) is a tax-free benefit for disabled children and adults to help with extra costs you may have because you're disabled. Find out more about Disability Living Allowance, including how much you can get.

#### Who can get Disability Living Allowance?

You may get Disability Living Allowance if:

- · you have a physical or mental disability, or
- your disability is severe enough for you to need help caring for yourself or you have walking difficulties, or both
- you are under 65 when you claim

Already claiming DLA and want to report a change in your circumstances - find out more

 Disability Living Allowance your circumstances

You can get Disability Living Allowance whether or not you work.

It isn't usually affected by any savings or income you may have.

If you're aged 65 or over, you may be able to get Attendance Allowance.

#### Special rules - if you're terminally ill

If you have a progressive disease and are not expected to live for more than another six months there are special rules. The special rules are to help you get your benefit more quickly and easily

### Register to vote

Use this service to apply to register to vote or to:

- update your name, address or other details on the electoral register
- change your voting preferences, for example to vote in person or by post
- change whether you're on the <u>open register</u>

It usually takes about 5 minutes.

This service is also available in Welsh (Cymraeg).

You may need the following, if you have them:

- your National Insurance number
- your passport if you're a British citizen living abroad

You need to be on the electoral register to vote in elections and referendums.

#### Visit someone in prison

Use this service to book a social visit to a prisoner in England or Wales.

You need the:

- prisoner number
- prisoner's date of birth
- dates of birth for all visitors coming with you

The prisoner must add you to their visitor list before you can book a visit.

You'll get an email confirming your visit. It takes 1 to 3 days.



#### What you need to know

Contact the prison directly if you need to arrange any of the following:

- legal visits, for example legal professionals discussing the prisoner's case
- official prison visits if you don't have the prisoner's date of birth and



#### 1. How it works

You could get £62.70 a week if you care for someone at least 35 hours a week and they get <u>certain benefits</u>.

You don't have to be related to, or live with, the person you care for.

You won't be paid extra if you care for more than one person.

Carer's Allowance can affect the <u>other benefits that you and the person</u> <u>you care for get</u>. You have to pay tax on it if your income is over the <u>Personal Allowance</u>.

#### 3. Make a lasting power of attorney

You can make a lasting power of attorney (LPA) online or using paper forms.

Either way, you need to get other people to sign the forms, including the attorneys and witnesses.

You can get someone else to use the online service or fill in the paper forms for you, for example a family member, friend or solicitor.

You must <u>register your LPA</u> or your attorney won't be able to make decisions for you.
