There are three holiday periods:

- ♦ Chistmas holiday (December-January)
- ♦ Easter holiday (March or April)
- Summer holiday (end of June-September)

Who to address in an Educational Center

The group of persons in charge of students' education is known as "Educational Community", which includes teachers, students, parents and organizations that somehow support the education (technical teachers for the community services, etc.).

- □ When presenting oneself in the Center for the first time, parents or tutors may address the Board of Directors, which include a Director, a Headmaster and a Secretary.
- ☐ In order to know how children are doing in different subjects, and to know about their behaviour, one must address the Class **Tutor**; this teacher is in charge of guiding students in that class throughout the educational process.
- Besides the Tutor, the high school Guidance Departments and the EOEP (Educational and Psychopedagogical Guidance Board), in Primary School, are able to give information on the children's school performance.
- Parents may participate in the Center decisions when voting their representantives for the Consejo Escolar (association in charge of discussing the Center educative policy) and through the AMPA (association of students' mothers and fathers).



THE MOST IMPORTANT...


- Education is compulsory and free from the age of 6 to 16
- ⊕ The regristration is done in the Educational Centers.
- There are the so-called public (free education), arranged (free education with probable complementing expenses) and private Educational Centers.

Which are the educational stages?

- Kindergarten and Infant School (0 to 3 years).
 (3 to 6 years)
- Primary

(6 to 12 years)

- Secondary (12 to 16 years) /
- Social Guarantee Programmes (16 to 20):
 With an entrance exam to middle grade
 Professional Education
- Secondary School Certificate / Middle Grade Professional Education (16 to 18 years)
- University / Higher Grade Professional Education
- In some cases, financial aid for school dining and other school aids are granted. For further information, one must address the Educational Center.
- Most schools have extra curricular activities, some of them for free.
- © Centers are open: on weekends and on holidays there are always Public Centers open in every District, where children may go for extra curricular activities.



<u>How to register children in school or high</u> school?

There are two registration periods: if done during March and April it is called ordinary period, and the requisites are:

- © Register directly in the Educational Centers (one must go to the nearest Center).
- Fill in the Center registration form.
- © Enclose the required documents (ID, census certification, and others).

Throughout the year, the extra period, which allows registration any time. For this period, one must:

- Go to the Permanent Scholarization Commission, which names the Centers students will attend. There is one of these centers per scholar district.
- Fill in the registration form.
- Enclose the required documents.

How about the school calendar?

For Kindergarten and Infant Education:

Infant public schools are open all year long, except in August. The schedule is 9:00 to 16:00. There are possibilities of extended schedules from 7:30 to 17:30.

For Primary and Secondary School (Basic compulsory):

School begins in mid-September and finishes at the end of June. The schedule depends on each center.
