

HOW TO GET TO NUEVOS MINISTERIOS

The airport metro is line 8 and is the quickest way to get to Nuevos Ministerios. The airport has two metro stations: "Aeropuerto T4", that serves Terminal 4, and "Aero-puerto T1-T2-T3" that serves the remaining Terminals.

- Stops "Aeropuerto T4": floor -1 of Terminal 4.
- "Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3": floor 1 of Terminal 2. Entry to the metro is located in the pedestrian passageway to parking lot P2, right in the middle of the Terminal.
- € Ticket price + airport supplement: 2 € ④ 6am to 1:30am. Approximate length of journey to
 - Nuevos Ministerios: 32 minutes.


Recommended route from Madrid-Barajas Airport to Nuevos Ministerios:

Take the number 8 line from the "Aeropuerto T4" or "Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3" metro stations (direction Nuevos Ministerios) and disembark at "Nuevos Ministerios".

From "Nuevos Ministerios". you can get to the city centre ("Sol" metro station) in just 4 minutes using the Cercanías city and suburban train. For this you will need to purchase a one-way Cercanías ticket, valid for a single journey for at any time during the 2 hours subsequent to its purchase (€1.20).







MADRID VISIÓN Route 2: Modern Madrid (90 mins)

HOW TO GET TO THE CITY CENTRE FROM THE AIRPORT

The airport metro is line 8 and is the quickest way to get to the city centre. The airport has two metro stations: "Aeropuerto T4", that serves Terminal 4, and "Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3" that serves the remaining Terminals.

- **Stops** "Aeropuerto T4": floor -1 of Ter-
- minal 4. "Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3": floor 1 of Terminal 2. Entry to the metro is located in the pedestrian passageway to parking lot P2, right in the middle of the Terminal.
- Ticket price + airport supplement: 2 € 6am to 1:30am.

Approximate length of journey to the centre: 56 minutes.

Recommended route from Madrid-Barajas Airport to the Centre of Madrid:

- Take the number 8 line from the "Aeropuerto T4" or "Aeropuerto T1-T2-T3" metro stations (direction Nuevos Ministerios) and disembark at "Colombia".
- "Colombia" transfer to line number 9 (direction Arganda del Rey) and disembark at "Príncipe Vergara".
- At "Príncipe de Vergara" transfer to line number 2 (direction Cuatro Caminos) and disembark at either "Retiro", "Banco de España" or "Sol", depending on where you are trying to get to.

The EMT city buses (lines 200 and 204) that serve Madrid-Barajas Airport depart every 10-13 minutes en route to the Avenida de América transport hub.

- Line 204 : arrivals T4.
- Line 200: arrivals T1 (opposite Baggage Claim Hall 2) and T2 (opposite Baggage Claim Hall 5).
- Ticket price: 1€ 5:36am to 11:30pm. Approximate length of journey: 30 mins.

Visitors to Madrid-Barajas Airport will find that there are a number of taxis available, and these take approximately 30 minutes to get to the city centre. Taxis in Madrid are white with a diagonal red stripe across their front door that also sports the city's coat-of-arms. A green light on the roof of the taxi indicates that the taxi is available.

1 THE RETIRO PARK (120 MINS)

Built in the 17th century during the reign of Philip IV, this is the most important (historically and artistically speaking) of all the parks in Madrid and is one of the most beautiful city parks in the world. The park was originally home to a set of buildings that comprised a large palace, and a garden with a host of features: hermitages, grottos, covered paths, ponds,

2 THE ART WALK (120 MINS)

The Art Walk is a singular experience that combines art, architecture and nature and is located in one of the most characteristic areas of the city: the Paseo del Prado. It makes for a very pleasant walk taking you past the Botanical Gardens as well as three of the most renowned museums in the world: the Prado Museum, the Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum and the Reina Sofia Museum and Art Gallery.



A STROLL THROUGH "HAPSBURG MADRID" (120 MINS)

The Plaza Mayor and the surrounding area was the centre of city life during the Hapsburg dynasty when, in 1561, Philip II chose Madrid as the official residence of the Spanish Royal Court. More information available from the Madrid Tourism Centre (Plaza Mayor, 27).



SHOPPING IN AND AROUND PUERTA DEL SOL (120 MINS)

The city centre is the very heart, both artistically and historically speaking, of Madrid. Here you can get a glimpse of the city's rich history as you shop along calles Mayor, Arenal, Preciados, Carmen or Gran Vía, that are home to a great selection of fashion houses (clothes, shoes and accessories) as well as some of the well-established department stores. In the Sol district, most stores are open 365 days a year.

6 DE TAPAS (120')
